

RULES FOR STOCK CLASS (4 MPH PACE)

3000#, 3500#, 4500#, 5500#, 6500#, 7500# 8500#

IF YOU GET DISQUALIFIED FROM THIS CLASS YOU WILL LOSE YOUR ENTRY FEE

RULES MARKED WITH * WILL BE CLOSELY MONITORED AND ENFORCED BY TRACK OFFICIAL; BEFORE, DURING AFTER EACH PULL

1. **ONLY "STOCK" AND "OFF THE FARM" TYPE TRACTORS ARE ALLOWED IN THIS CLASS*** Farmers and tractor enthusiasts are encouraged to drive their tractors right in from the farm or home. There will be a prize for the tractor driven the furthest.
2. **AGE** - Tractors can be of any age.
3. **APPEARANCE** - Tractors must have Stock appearance*
4. **SIDE SHIELDS** - No engine side shields are permitted
5. **ENGINE** - Tractors must have stock block and serial # for that year, make and model.
6. **HP** - Tractors are expected to be "Stock" horsepower*
7. **RPM** - Tractors are permitted to run up to 20% over stock RPM*
8. **FUEL** - Tractors must run on only Stock fuel designed for that tractor.
9. **TURBO** - Turbos are not allowed
10. **SHIFT ON THE GO** - is not allowed
11. **TIRES** - Two sizes over stock rear tire size is allowed*
12. **WEIGHTS** - Weights may extend frontward no more than 24" in front of tractor casting and backward the rear weights can be any reasonable distance. All weights must be safely and securely fastened.
13. **HITCH** - For your own safety, if the tractor has no wheelie bars, then original length hitch (about 13" to 14" behind PTO) is mandatory. If you shorten your hitch, install wheelie bars.
14. **Tractors in the Stock class can also pull in any other class because they already meet the rules to pull in any other class.**

ADDITIONAL RULES FOR FARM CLASS (6 MPH PACE)

4800#, 5800#, 6800#, 8800#, 9800#, 10,800#, 13,800#, 17,800#

1. **TURBO** - Turbos are allowed, if tractor came from factory with turbo
2. **SHIFT ON THE GO** - is allowed., if tractor came from factory with shift on the go
3. **TIRES** - Maximum rear tire size is 18.4 x 42" in classes up to 9800# and any size tires in classes above 9800#.

ADDITIONAL RULES FOR HOT BLOCK CLASS (UNPACED)

~~3250#, 4250#, 4500#, 5250#, 6250#~~, 7900#, 8900#, 10,900#, 12,500#

1. **AGE** - Tractors can be of any age.
2. **APPEARANCE** - Tractors may have altered appearance
3. **ENGINE** - Tractors must have stock block for that year, make and model.
4. **HP** - any horsepower allowed
5. **RPM** - If RPM exceeds twice original factory specifications, then safety equipment such as a bellhousing blanket or flywheel wrap is mandatory. In the opinion of the track officials, any tractor operating unsafely will be disqualified
6. **FUEL** - Tractors may be **MODIFIED** and may run any fuel.
7. **TURBO** - Turbos are allowed
8. **P - PUMPS** - No P pumps in 8900# and under classes.
9. **KILL SWITCH** - Kill switch is mandatory in unpaced classes
10. **SHIFT ON THE GO** - is allowed
11. **TIRES** - Any tire size is allowed
12. **WEIGHTS** - Weights may extend frontward no more than 24" in front of tractor casting and backward the rear weights can be any reasonable distance. All weights must be safely and securely fastened.
13. **HITCH** - For your own safety, if the tractor has no wheelie bars, then original length hitch (about 13" to 14" behind PTO) is mandatory. If you shorten your hitch, install wheelie bars.

GENERAL "BACK TO THE BASICS" RULES

1. **Safety First.** Always think safety. Always act safely. Drive slow, look around, think of others. Drive like your father and mother are watching you. **All contestants enter at your own risk.**
2. **This Year's Rules** are listed here. If you don't like this year's rules, contact a track official to have your proposed changes considered for next year.
3. **Prize Money and/or Trophies** will be awarded to the top finishers depending on the number of entries.
4. **Registration** cards must be completely filled out and signed. Only one pull, per class, per tractor.
5. **Order of pull** within each class will be in order of registration.
6. **Age of Driver** must be 12 years or older. Driver 12 - 18 years of age must have written permission from parent or legal guardian to enter tractor pull and present a farm safety course certification. Driver must be 18 or older to drive in unpaced classes.
7. If **Powder Puff Classes** are held, they are for females only. The Powder Puff Classes allow different ladies to pull the same tractor in the same class. No other classes allow this sharing.
8. **Fenders** are mandatory. **Kill switch** and **wheelie bars** are recommended but not mandatory except in unpaced classes. Wheelie bars must be strong enough to hold weight of tractor when tested. If no wheelie bars, tractor will be flagged to stop when the front wheels exceed a safe height as determined solely by the Track Official (about knee high).
9. **Tires** may be mounted forwards or backwards. No tracks, duals, or chains allowed. Factory steel wheels are not allowed.
10. **Drawbar Height** not to exceed 20" for all tractor classes. Drawbar must be at least 18" back of center of the rear axle and rigid in all directions. Hitch must be equipped with a 2 1/2" clevis or 2 1/2" pulling eye. No floating drawbar. Two or three point hitch, if used, may not rise at all during the pull.
11. **Scale** is available to weigh tractor as many times as necessary before the hook. Every tractor may have to cross the scale immediately after the hook is completed to verify official weight and hitch height.
12. **Tractor Tracks Eliminator.** Once the tractor starts pulling the eliminator, there are no controls in the cab that will affect the progressive increase in friction to stop the tractor except the cab brakes. If the brakes are applied for any reason (such as an equipment failure or a kid crossing the track), the red lights automatically come on. Everyone gets an honest hook without "dropping the pan." Computers on the eliminator automatically send instantaneous speed and distant measurements to the track announcer and to the digital scoreboard at the end of the track.
13. **Paced Classes** have an extremely loud air horn system linked directly to the main computer in the cab of the eliminator. It will honk automatically when the actual ground speed exceeds the pace set by the rules and it stops when the ground speed is reduced enough to fall under the pace setting. At the finish line of the track is an extra large digital display updated by computer four times a second which is visible to the tractor driver and the spectators while the puller is driving down the track. The eliminator driver can honk the horn as necessary to adjust tractor engine RPM's until the 100 foot mark (double cones), but if the horn honks, even slightly, after the eliminator operator goes past the double cones, the tractor driver is disqualified.
14. **Chain** must be tightened slowly to get the green light. The pull must start with no jerks. All tractors must be in neutral while hooking up.
15. **Track Officials** have the right to stop a tractor at any time and their decision is final. Track Officials or Pull Organizers have the right to reject or disqualify any entry at any time before, during, or after the pull.
16. **Track Boundary** violation occurs when any wheels of the tractor touch the side boundary line. Pull will be measured from that distance if the driver stops promptly when flagged.
17. **Driver's Butt** must remain in the tractor seat at all times. Leaning is allowed.
18. **Pull** stops when the forward motion of the eliminator stops. Weights must be secured. If anything falls off of tractor before it is unhooked, the tractor is disqualified.
19. **Nitrous injection not allowed.** Tractors must use only stock fuel for the model.
20. **Driver's Meeting** rule changes made by Pull Officials at the Driver's Meeting take priority over these printed rules.
21. **No Crybabies.** Treat the volunteer workers with respect. They aren't getting paid. They are contributing their time. Talk to a track official if you have any questions or concerns.
22. **Have Fun.** We are here to have fun. If we don't have fun we won't want to do this again.
