1. Drawbars in all Classes no higher than 20 inches.
2. NO cut tires in paced classes. No tires larger than 16.9-38 in classes AA-AB-AC. NO stripping tractors to make weight.
3. All weights must be securely fastened. If weight falls off you will be disqualified.
4. All tractors that came with fenders from factory must have them on.
5. Unpaced classes must have safety equipment (Wheelie bars, Kill switches, Safety blankets)
6. All decisions by Officials are final. Tractor Tracks, LLC, to serve as Track Official and their Eliminator will be used.
7. **Maximum 2 classes per tractor!**
8. All contestants enter at their own risk. No drivers under the age of 16 are allowed.
9. All trucks and trailers must be parked in the in-field. NO parking by back gate.
10. Carry-in alcoholic beverages will subject participants to elimination from event. **STRICTLY ENFORCED -- NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN INFIELD.**

NOTE: THESE RULES ARE SET UP TO GIVE EVERY TRACTOR ENTERED, AN HONEST AND FAIR CHANCE OF PLACING IN ITS CLASS. DO NOT TRY TO ABUSE THESE RULES TO GAIN A COMPETITIVE EDGE.
