General Rules for all Pullers

1. Safety first. Always think safety. Drive slowly, look around, and think of others.
2. Please bring up issues at the drivers meeting not after pull starts. If there is any arguing with announcers, volunteers, officials, etc. you will be asked to leave with no refund. Be respectful to the help. Thanks.
3. All contestants enter at their own risk. (see sheet)
4. Order of pull within each class will be determined by order of registration. All tractors must post pull number on side of tractor.
5. Drivers must be age 14. Age 14-17 years must have written permission from parents or legal guardians to enter tractor pull, and present a farm safety course certification. Drivers must be 18 to drive in open or unpaced classes.
6. Driver must remain in tractor seat at all times, and operate the tractor in a safe manner at all times, on and off the track. Think safety of others and yourself.
7. Kill switches, wheelie bars, and fenders are recommended but not mandatory. Wheelie bars must be strong enough to hold tractor when tested. If no wheelie bars, then tractor will be flagged to stop when the front wheels exceed knee high above the track.
8. All tires must be on the tractor. Tires may be mounted forwards or backwards. No tracks allowed.
9. Nothing may be added, or taken off the tractor after you are officially weighed in.
10. The pull will start with a tight hook-up with no jerks.
11. If anything falls off the tractor before it is unhooked from the eliminator, the tractor is disqualified.
12. All tractors must be in neutral while hooking up.
13. The officials have the right to stop any entry at any time during the pull, and reserve the right to disqualify or deny entry at any time (even after the pull). The official's word is final.
14. The pull shall be considered over when the forward motion of the load stops.
15. Any tractor violating the track boundary will be measured from that distance if driver stops promptly.
16. Drawbar must be at least 18" back of center of the rear axel. Tractors must be equipped with 2 1/2" clevis or pulling eye. No moving drawbars after final weigh in. Hitch height will be checked prior to hooking eliminator. NO Floating Draw Bars!!!!
17. No massy 44, Oliver 88, Farmall M, M-M U and UB shall enter any class below 4,500 lbs.
18. No T.A of Power Shift may be used.
19. Only one pull per weight class per tractor, unless a distance tie requires a pull-off.
20. Each tractor may pull up to three per day if tractor meets all respective rules for class.
21. NO alcohol may be consumed by drivers while operating any tractor.
22. All drovers should be in line and ready to pull at the start of their weight class.
23. No registrations after start of each respective class.
24. Official decisions made at driver's meeting take priority over printed rules for safety matters only.
25. Classes may be added or subtracted on the day of the pull.
26. Have Fun!! We are here to have fun. If we don't have fun we won't do this again.
27. **50 ft rule:** can move weights before 50 ft. cone and restart also after the 50 ft cone. On the 2nd horn blast the tractor/driver will be disqualified for excessive speed.
28. Pure Stock can move up 1 class in pure stock class. Improved stock and Antique and all other classes cannot pull in pure stock.
29. 4 or more tractors in class for 50% payback.
30. No turbos in any class but Super Antique.

Additional Rules for Pure Stock Classes (3.5 mph)

1. Age: Tractor must be 1957 or older.
2. RPM's according to the serial number of tractor and according to the Nebraska Test.
3. Tires: Maximum rear tire size is 13.6"-3,000 LB class, 15.5"-4,000 LB class, 15.5-5,000 LB class, 16.9-6,000 LB class and 16.9-7,000 LB class
4. Tractor must have stock model block, carburetor, and serial number for the make and model
5. Tractors must run only on STOCK FUEL designed for that tractor.
6. Weights: Weight brackets are ok. No weights in front of front end casting.
7. All other general rules apply.
8. Must be stock rear hubs, no pressed rims unless model came stock with them.
9. Pure stock may go up with 1 hook higher.

Additional Rules for Improved Stock Classes (3.5 MPH)

1. Age: Tractor must be 1957 or older.
2. RPM: No more than 20% RPM's according to serial number of tractor and according to the Nebraska Test.
3. Improved Stock cannot pull in Pure Stock Class.
4. Tires: Maximum rear tire size is, 15.5"-4,00 lb class, 15.5"-5,000 lb class, 16.9"-6,000 lb class, and 16.9"-7,000 lb class.
5. Tractor must have stock model block, carburetor, and serial number for the make and model.
6. Tractors must run only on STOCK FUEL designed for that tractor.
7. Tractor in Improved Stock Classes can pull in the Antique Classes (Paced). They must meet rules for that class.
8. Weights: weight brackets are ok. No weight in front on front end casting.
9. All other general rules apply.
10. Pressed Rim's allowed in Improved.

Additional Rules for Antique Classes (4.0)

1. Age: Tractors must be 1957 or older.
2. Antique cannot pull in Pure Stock Class
3. Weights: Weights may extend frontward no more than 24" in front of the tractor casting and backward 24" from center of the axel. Weights should be safely fastened.
4. Antique tractors must have stock block for that make and model. No 12 port heads, M-M800 parts, Alcohol fuel, or nitrous oxide..
5. All other general rules apply.

Additional Rules for Super Antique Classes (8.0 MPH)

1. Age: Tractors must be 1958 or older.
2. Weights: Weights may extend frontward no more than 24" in front of tractor casting and backward 24" from center of the axel. Weights should be safely fastened.
3. Antique tractors must have stock block for that make and model. No alcohol fuel, nitrous gas, or ether is allowed. Officials will test and check for nitrous fuel injections.
4. All other general rules apply.
