UPON ENTERING GROUNDS,
PLEASE WEIGH-IN, REGISTER,
& GET IN LINE FOR DYNO
(As Needed) RIGHT AWAY!!!!!!

**Any series that started production in 1953 will be allowed to pull as long as that series was manufactured.

**Maximum RPM's limited to No-Load PTO RPM's according to M&W Sheets.

**All Tractors Subject to Inspection.

**All Winners in Classes will be dyno'd, re-weighed, and drawbar re-checked.

**AFTER PULLING, ALL TRACTORS MUST WAIT IN HOLDING AREA. ANY TRACTOR LEAVING THIS AREA WITHOUT JUDGE'S CLEARANCE WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY DISQUALIFIED. NO EXCUSES!

1. THE HARRISVILLE TRACTOR PULL COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REJECT OR DISQUALIFY ANY ENTRY. The Judge's decision is final. Any arguing will result in disqualification.
2. Tractor must be 1953 or older stock farm tractor. Fenders ARE required.
3. Drawbar height not to exceed 20".
4. Front weight WILL NOT exceed ahead of front wheels more than 24" or 24" behind rear wheels. Weights must not interfere with the hookup. If anything breaks or falls off the tractor, the tractor will be disqualified.
5. Puller must furnish own **twisted clevis** or puller's eye to accept eliminator hook or NO HOOK. (Minimum 3" hole and NO STRAIGHT CLEVIS). **Pulling point can be no more than 1.5" from back edge of hitching device.**
6. All tractors must have a working PTO.
7. Driver must remain fully seated ON SEAT during entire pull and operate tractor in a safe manner.
8. Tractor must stay within boundaries or will be disqualified.
9. All contestants enter at their own risk and will sign a waiver. Anyone under 18 must show a Tractor Safety Certificate and have a consent form signed by parent/guardian.
10. Tractors finishing in 2nd or 3rd place will be subject to the Dyno or re-weighing by \$10 request only. Money must be given to Judges only.
11. The use of a tork amplifier is prohibited.

**NO DRINKING BEFORE PULLING!!!

*****As of 2008---Permanent throttle stops are required. NO vise grips allowed. No Excuses!!***

****ALL TRACTORS IN SPECIAL CLASSES SUBJECT TO CUBIC INCH PUMP TEST OR TEARDOWN.**

>ALL TRACTORS SUBJECT TO INSPECTION. THIS INCLUDES HOT FARM & OPEN CLASSES.

>MAXIMUM RPM'S LIMITED TO NO-LOAD PTO RPM'S ACCORDING TO M&W SHEETS.

>3000 MAXIMUM RPM'S (DOES NOT INCLUDE OPEN CLASSES)

>ALL CONTESTANTS "PLACING" IN CLASSES WILL BE DYNO'D, RE-WEIGHED, DRAWBAR RE-CHECKED, OR RPM'S CHECKED WHEN APPLICABLE.

>AFTER PULLING, ALL TRACTORS MUST WAIT IN HOLDING AREA. ANY TRACTOR LEAVING THIS AREA WITHOUT JUDGE'S CLEARANCE WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY DISQUALIFIED. NO EXCUSES!!!

1. THE HARRISVILLE TRACTOR PULL COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REJECT OR DISQUALIFY ANY ENTRY. THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL. ANY ARGUING WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.
2. FARM CLASSES APPLY TO TRACTORS THAT ARE USED FOR FARM WORK ON THE FARM ON A ROUTINE BASIS. ANY TRACTOR NOT QUALIFIED FOR FARM CLASSES MUST PULL IN "SPECIAL", "HOT FARM", OR "OPEN" CLASSES.
3. FARM CLASS TRACTORS MUST BE FARMER-OWNED AND FARMER-DRIVEN AND EQUIPPED WITH A WORKING PTO, FENDERS, AND FAN. DRIVER MUST REMAIN SEATED ON SEAT DURING THE PULL. NO JERKS ALLOWED.
4. NO CUT TIRES ALLOWED EXCEPT IN THE "OPEN" CLASSES.
5. ALL WEIGHTS MUST BE SAFELY & SECURELY FASTENED TO TRACTOR. ANYTHING FALLING OFF RESULTS IN DISQUALIFICATION.
6. FRONT WHEEL OF TRACTOR MUST NOT RAISE TO AN UNSAFE HEIGHT ACCORDING TO JUDGE'S DISGRESSION.
7. MAXIMUM DRAWBAR HEIGHT IS 20". PINHOLE MINIMUM IS 18" FROM CENTER OF AXLE. ANYONE PULLING A TRACTOR WITH A 3-POINT HITCH WILL BE DISQUALIFIED IF DRAWBAR RISES OR CHANGES POSITION AFTER START OF PULL. DRAWBAR MUST BE ACCESSIBLE. PULLER MUST FURNISH OWN TWISTED CLEVIS OR PULLER'S EYE TO ACCEPT ELIMINATOR HOOK OR NO HOOK. (MINIMUM 3" HOLE & NO STRAIGHT CLEVIS). PULLING POINT CAN BE NO MORE THAN 1.5' FROM BACK EDGE OF HITCHING DEVICE.
8. ALL CONTESTANTS ENTER AT THEIR OWN RISK AND WILL SIGN A WAIVER. ANYONE UNDER 18 MUST SHOW A TRACTOR SAFETY CERTIFICATE AND HAVE A CONSENT FORM SIGNED BY PARENT/GUARDIAN.
9. TRACTOR MUST STAY WITHIN BOUNDARIES OR WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
10. STOCK CONFIGURATION OF TRACTOR REQUIRED.

****WE ALSO ENCOURAGE OTHER SAFETY EQUIPMENT SUCH AS ROLL BARS, SAFETY BELTS, SHUT-OFFS, AND DEAD MAN'S THROTTLE IN CLASSES WHERE THEY ARE NOT "REQUIRED".**

NEW CLASS---12,000#--300 HP Farm Tractor Class

1. 466 cubic inch limit
2. Each tractor subject to pump test.
3. 2800 RPM's.
4. Stock Block & Stock core injection pump.
5. Must be Farm Stock appearing. No side shields.
6. RPM's-----200 RPM's over no-load, high-idle factory specs according to M & W sheets.
7. Working PTO. Any PTO "slippage" results in disqualification.
8. 3LM or TO4 Equivalent Turbo (Inlet 2.65"). No waste gate or equivalent devices.
9. No water—no nitrous—no alcohol—no electric fans or electric water pumps.
10. Max. Tire Size 20.8. Absolutely no cut tires in any way.
Pressed steel is OK. No aluminum rims.
11. Air shut-off, deadman's throttle, & wheely bars—recommended.
12. All general rules apply.
